As many of you know, Daniel Lui and Catherine Kim traveled to Gong-Yi, China in March to visit the Home of Hope Orphanage (HOH). Our goal was to learn as much as we could from Nathan Bell, who has now opened up 4 orphanages in different parts of China. We had so many questions for him, from "How did you open up the first orphanage?" to "How are you able to support each of these children?" to "How are you able to work directly with the local governments?"

Well, Nathan provided more than we could have ever imagined. He walked us through every detail of his journey [with God] in China, opening up the 4 HOH orphanages. He also blessed us with first-hand experience in how an orphanage is run on a day-to-day basis. We were able to explore and experience the HOH campus, neighborhoods, local hospitals/clinics, and schools; and how all these establishments were intertwined into the daily lives of HOH's orphan children. The experience and knowledge gained from this trip has become invaluable to our personal growth, in addition to the growth of GivingBackLife.

For the entire month of August, Daniel Lui and his new wife, Lily Hsu, will have the privilege to join Nathan and the orphans of Gong-Yi. They will hopefully be integrated into the orphanage as staff members in order to take part in the day-to-day operations. More specifically, Daniel will be working directly with a local family physician (Dr. Lou) for an elective learning month in China. Lily will be taking a break from her graduate studies to learn what it takes to be an educator in China; hopefully having the opportunity to spend a month teaching English to the orphanage children. Their separate apprenticeships will help prepare us to one day start our own orphanage, medical clinic, and school.

How to help? Daniel and Lily are in desperate need of both financial and spiritual support. Would you dedicate a day in August to pray for the two of them (e.g., safety, health, learning, divine appointments)?
